Parsley Species: Florida, Utah and 96	Increasing harvest in plots to be picked in February-April only	5 weeks after estimated harvest date	75cc (30ppm)
Anemones	Stem extension	3-4 sprayings starting 3-4 weeks before bloom	37-75cc (15-30ppm)
Dutch Iris	Delaying blossoming by 10 days and extending the stem by ~4cm	Near planting	1. 410cc (after regular cooling for 24H) 2. 820cc (after regular cooling for one hour)
