Fungicide against dodder in gourds, vines and herbs and potato blight in potatoes and tomatoes

Contains: 9% dimethomorph, 60% mancozeb

General: Acrobat 69 is a mixture of the dimethomorph (FRAC Group 40) and mancozeb (FRAC Group M03) fungicides. Dimethomorph penetrates the plant tissue and exterminates the fungus in the leaf or stem. Mancozeb penetrates the plant and serves as a protectant. Both substances act differently on the fungus. Dimethomorph is effective against Ridomil-resistant trunks and other substances of the same group (phenyl-resistant). To prevent Dimethomorph resistance, do not spray Acrobat 69 continuously, but occasionally use other substances of other groups.

Herbs: Basil, Mint, Sage, Thyme, Rosemary, Tarragon, Marjoram, Melissa, Parsley, Dill, Cilantro, Arugula, Spring Onion, Celery, Rocket Lettuce, Mizuna, Spinach, Chard, Red Chard and Bull's Blood, Tatsui Leaves	Downy Mildew	200	7	30-50 l/dunam, to full coverage
